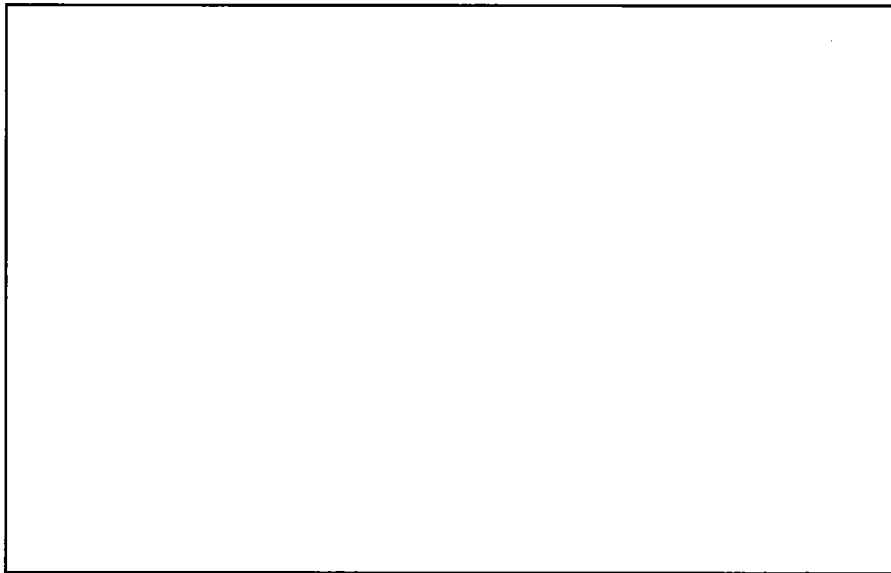

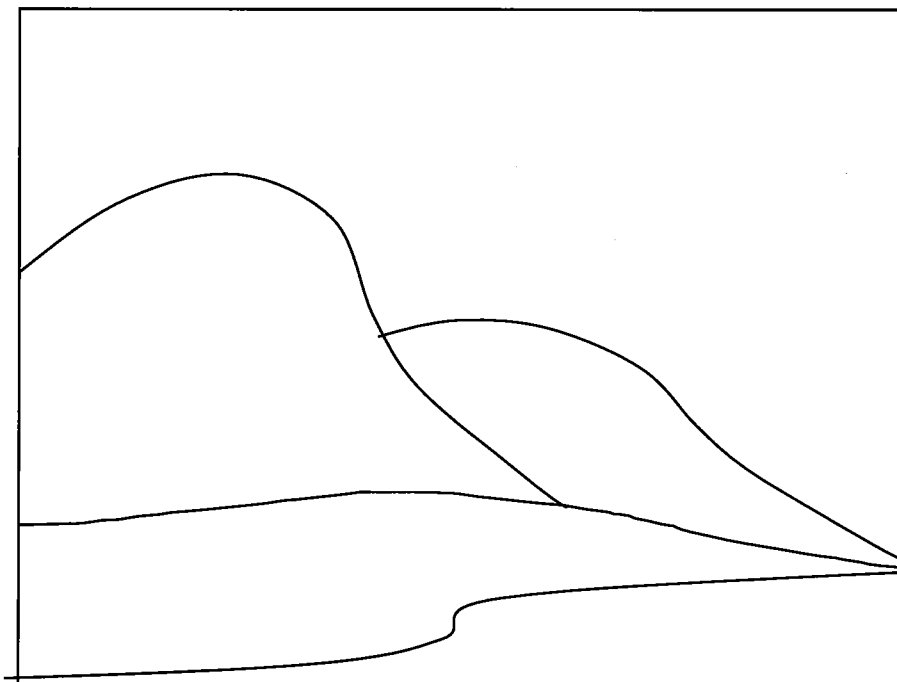
Section A: Free Hand Sketching (60%)

1. **Man-made object:** Sketch the three 3-dimensional (3D) view of a dining table and chair in the box below.

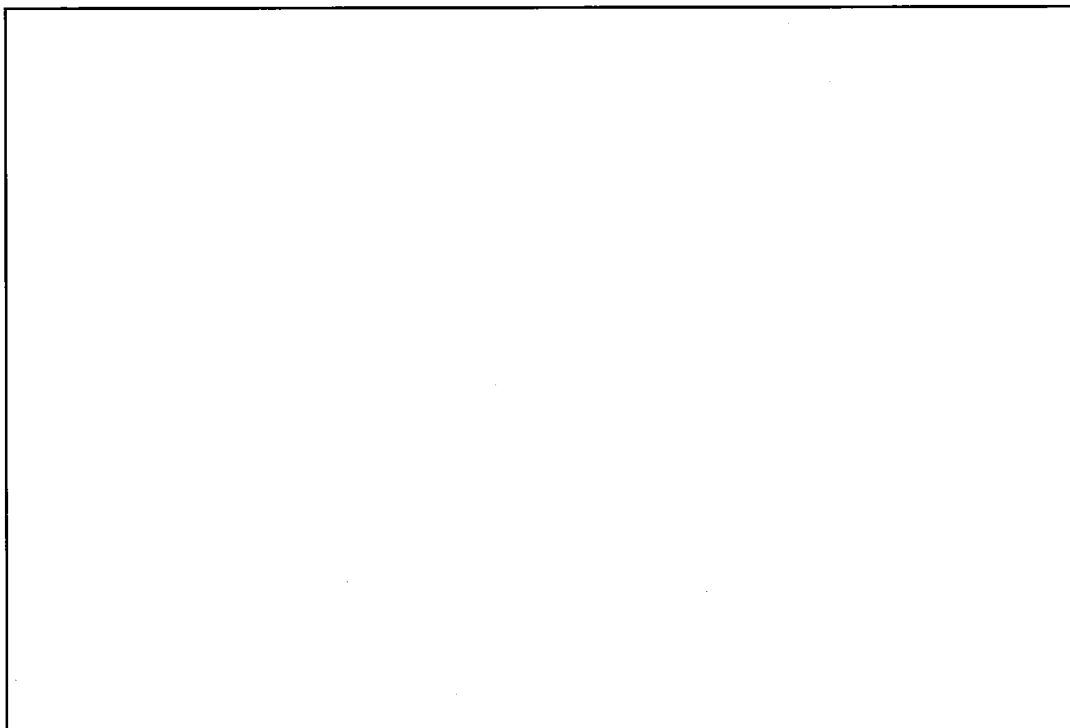


2. **Landscape:** Draw and complete the picture using any three (3) of these objects – trees, stones, hut, car, building, or people. You may add other things for the background, but not too much.

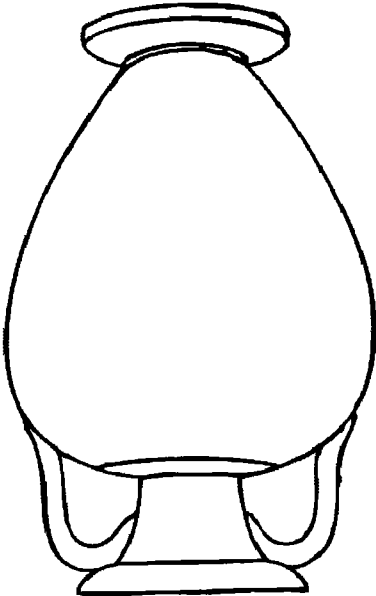


3. **Enlargement/Proportion:**

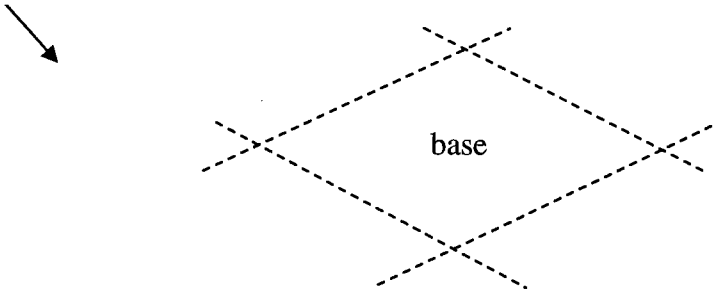
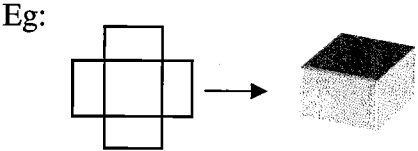
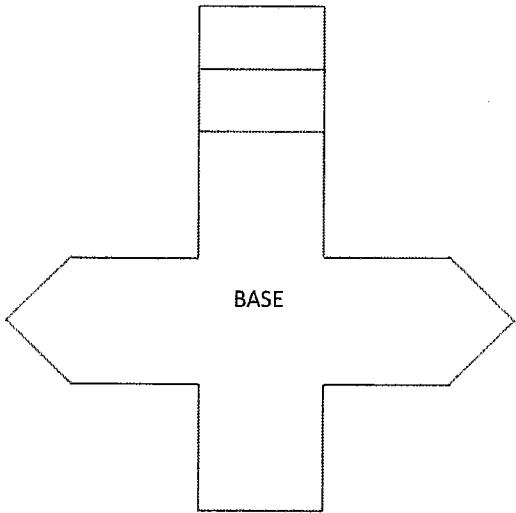
Draw the enlarged view of the picture shown to fill up the box below. The proportions should be maintained. There is no need to shade. **DO NOT USE ANY RULER.**



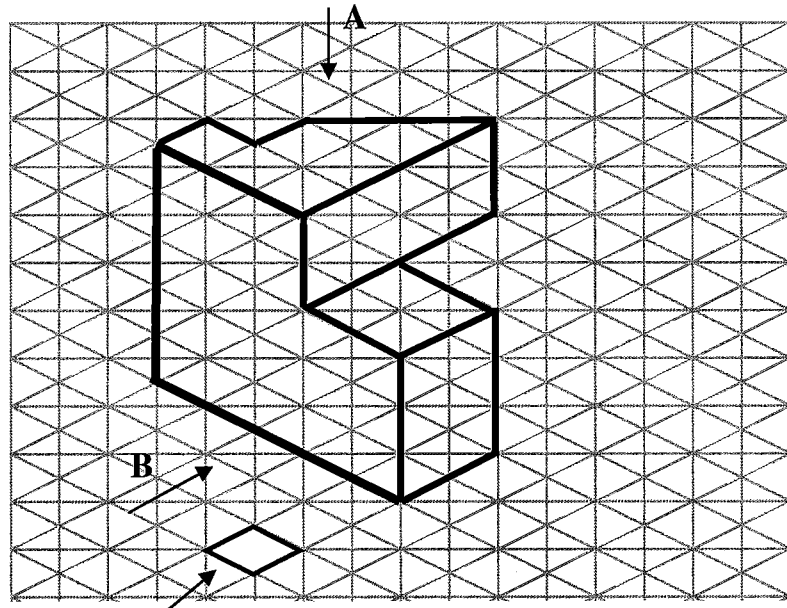
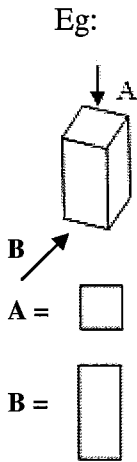
4. **Shading:** You are to use a B/2B pencil to gradually shade the object from dark to light.



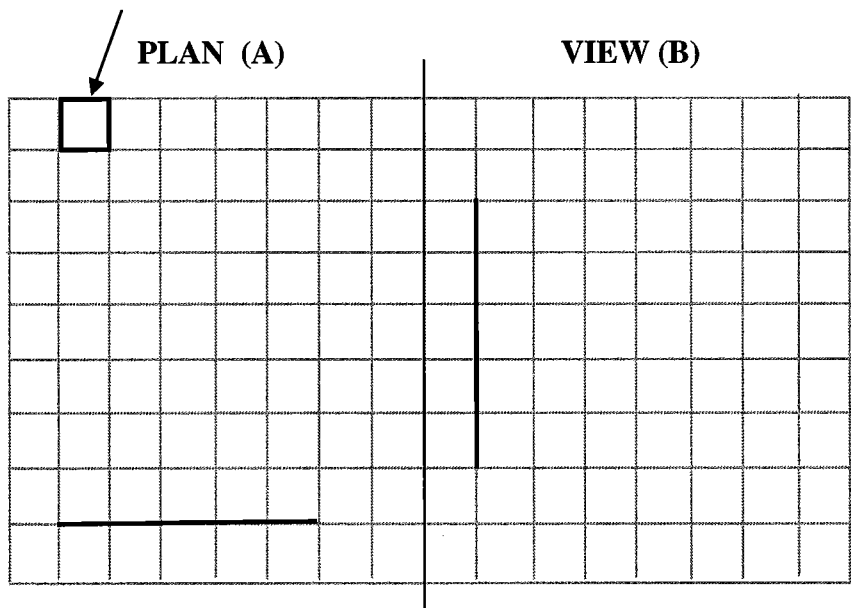
5. **Solid forms:** The plan below shows the planes of an object. Sketch out the 3D form if these planes were folded up. Use the dotted guidelines given as the starting point.



6. **Orthographic Views:** Sketch the plan (A) and side view (B) of the 3D form shown below. Two lines have been drawn for you.



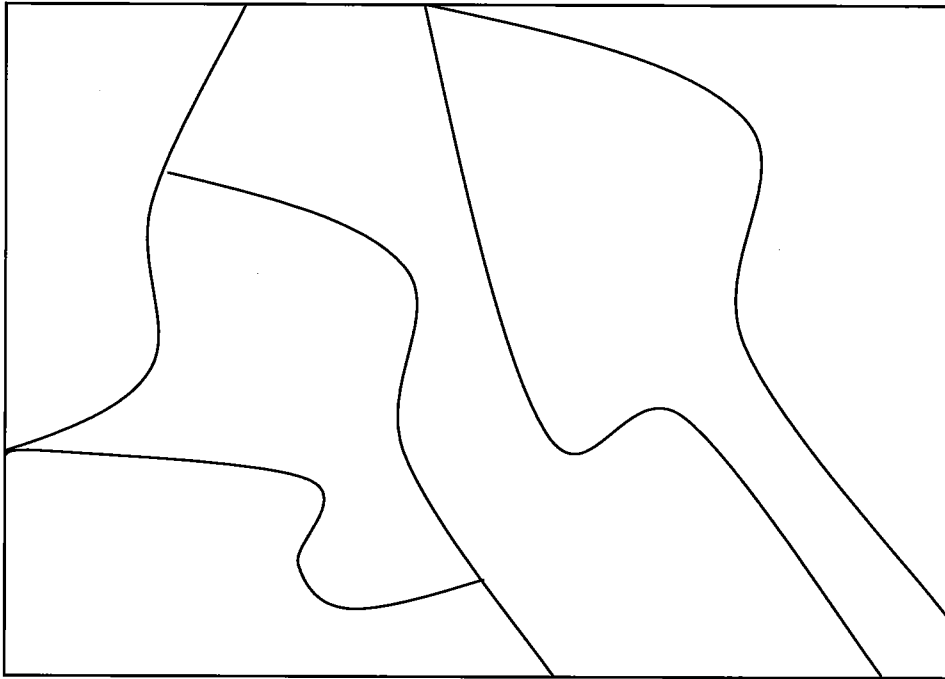

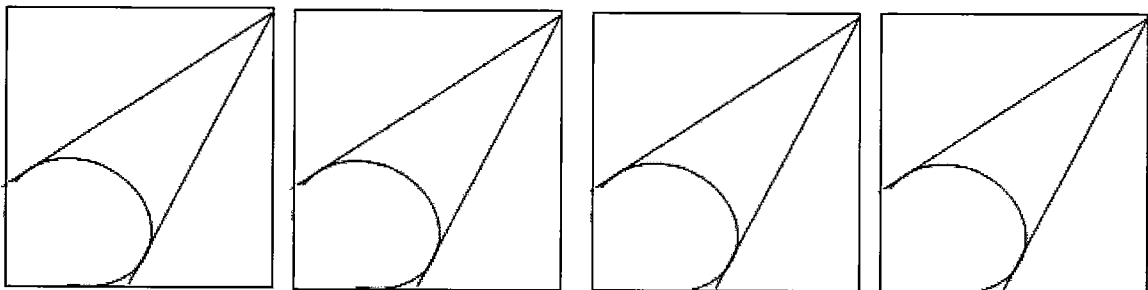
Section B: Creative Composition (40%)

- You should spend not more than 30 minutes in this section.

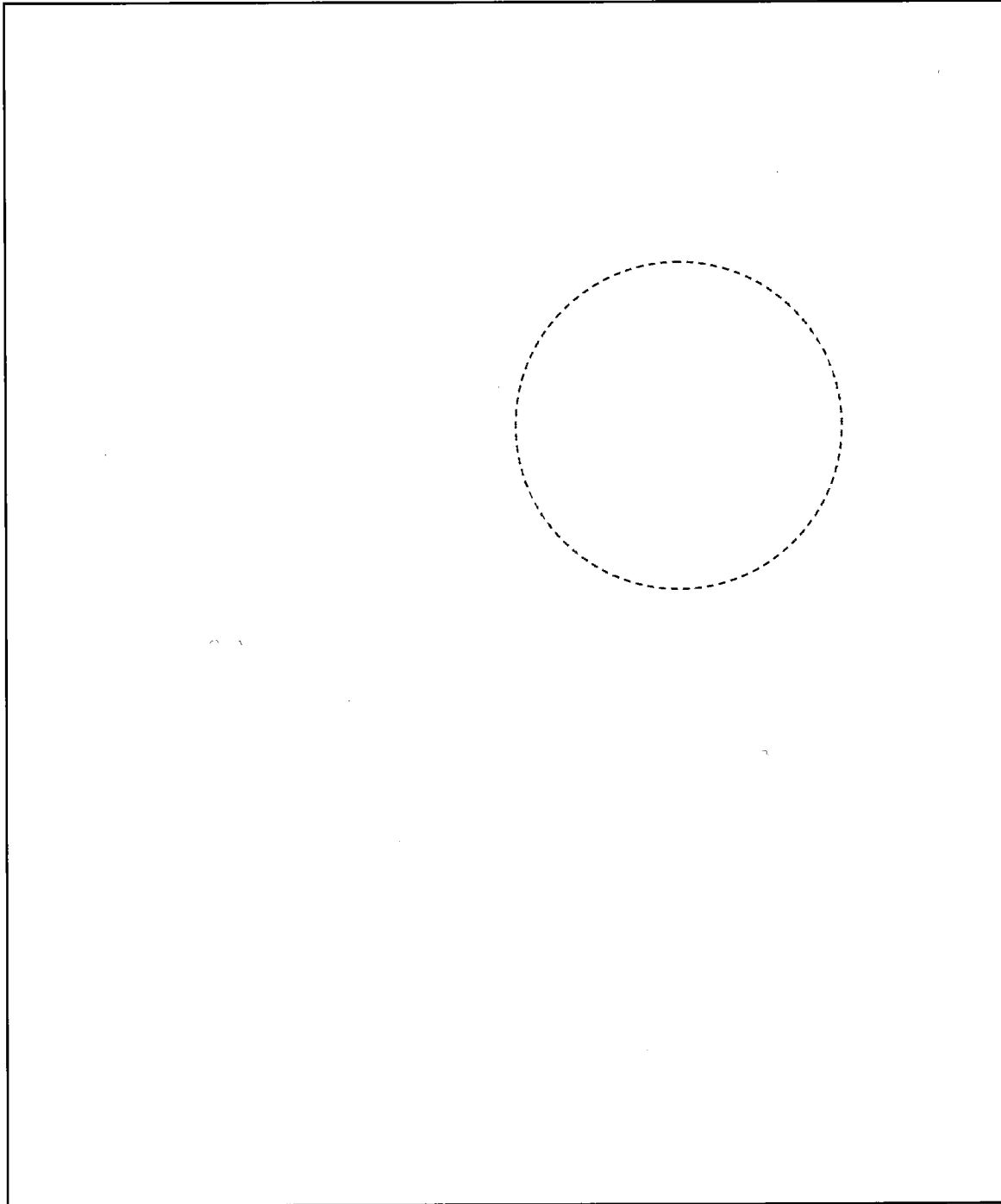
7. (a) Colour the diagram below with 3 to 5 colours. You may use any technique to do it. (10 marks)
