EXAMINATION RULES AND CODE OF CONDUCT

- a) Students are to be present at least 15 minutes before the start of the examination. No student is allowed to enter the examination hall 30 minutes after the examination has commenced.
- b) Students are not allowed to leave the examination hall within the first 30 minutes and the last 15 minutes of the examination.
- c) Students are not allowed to bring their belongings into the examination hall.
- d) Students are not allowed to bring into the examination hall any book, paper or unauthorised material, unless authorised to do so. If a student is found to possess any unauthorised materials, it will be confiscated and the student will be referred to the Academy for misconduct.
- e) No handphone or other electronic device is allowed in the examination hall.
- f) Students are only allowed to use calculators that do not have communication or text-editing functions. No programmable calculator is allowed during the examination.
- g) No sharing of stationeries and calculators are allowed during the examination.
- h) Students are required to put their identification card/passport (with photo) on the right hand corner of the desk for identification purpose. Those without any identification card may be disallowed to sit for the
- i) Students may read the examination paper or commence writing only after the examiner has given the permission to do so.
- j) During the examination, students are not allowed to communicate with one another. If they have any questions, they should remain seated and raise their hands to inform the invigilator.
- k) Students are not allowed to leave their seats without permission.
- l) Upon completion of the examination, students are not allowed to remove the examination paper and any written paper from the examination hall. Examination papers and any written paper must be submitted together with the answer booklets.

m) No dictionary is allowed in the examination venue.

n) Disciplinary actions will be taken against any candidate caught cheating or trying to cheat. This may include expulsion from the programme.
